The "Left Hand Rule"

Most disconnect handles are mounted on the RIGHT side.

To operate a disconnect switch, always:

- ✓ Stand to the right side of the switch, not in front of the box
- Grab the disconnect with your LEFT hand
- ✓ Turn your body & face away from the switch
- Close your eyes
- Take a deep breath and hold it
- ✓ Then "throw" the disconnect lever
